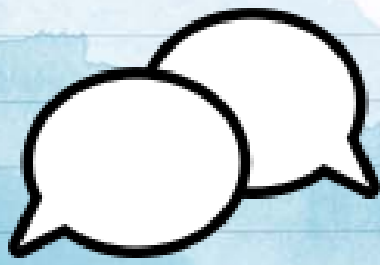

- ✓ Students prove English proficiency by:
  - completing all English language arts requirements for graduation.
  - scoring  $\geq 19$  on the Reading and English parts of the ACT test series.

*and one of the following*
- ✓ Students prove a different first language by:
  - attaining the Early Advanced proficiency level on the **English Language Development Assessment (ELDA)**.

*or*
- ✓ Students prove a second language acquired by:
  - passing a world language Advanced Placement (AP) test with a 3 or higher.
  - passing a world language International Baccalaureate (IB) test with a 4 or higher.
  - successfully completing a four-year high school course series in a world language.
  - earning 7 Carnegie units or more in a world language immersion setting.
  - earning a foreign government's certificate of competency at the B2.

### Freshman Automatic Admission Requirements

- **GPA:** 3.0 academic GPA based on Required High School Courses
- **Test Score Requirement (ACT, New SAT, or Old SAT):**
  - **ACT:** 22 composite score, with at least
    - 19 math subscore
    - 18 English subscore
  - **New SAT<sup>®</sup>:** 1100 total score, with at least
    - 500 math score
    - 25 writing and language score
  - **Old SAT:** 1030 critical reading & math score, with at least
    - 460 math score
    - 450 critical reading score

\*These requirements are only valid for students entering LSU in the Summer 2017, Fall 2017, and Spring 2018 semesters.

### Additional Factors for Admission

Students who are borderline to meeting admission requirements are still encouraged to apply. Other factors considered for admission may include choice of degree program, rank in class, credit in advanced placement or honors courses, rigor of the high school curriculum, and grade trends

## Louisiana Seal of Biliteracy

\_\_\_\_\_ High School will award the Seal of Biliteracy to graduating seniors who fulfilled all required English Language Arts coursework, passed the Reading and English parts of the ACT with a 19 or above and who fit at least one of the following criteria:

- Scored a 3+ on a World Language AP exam
- Scored a 4+ on a World Language IB exam
- Passed four years of a World Language high school levels I – IV
- Achieved 7+ Carnegie units in an Immersion setting
- Received the B2 DELF or DELE
- Earned an Advanced-Low on the AAPPL



Or

- Passed the ELDA with an Early Advanced Proficiency
